

Users will:

- Not attend the activity if you or anyone else attending in your group feel unwell, or have symptoms or if someone in their household has symptoms associated with Coronavirus
- Arrive and leave punctually and not congregate inside or outside the Sports Centre.
- Come already changed for your session and bring own water bottles for the session.
- Book and pay for the session in advance. No cash payments accepted.
- Adhere to the guidelines set out by your governing body of sport (hirers of the GBSC) and be responsible for supplying the centre with a risk assessment, communicating and overseeing this with your team / visitors.
- Observe themselves and remind others that when moving around the Sports Centre and 3G there is a strict 2 metre distancing rule – visible with the use of signage and floor markings
- Follow the safety measures put in place by the Sports Centre to minimise the risk of transmission of the virus. These include:
 - Use of hand sanitiser on entry to and exit from the Sports Centre, within the Centre and on the 3G Pitch
 - 2 metre social distancing to be followed in all circulation space and teaching rooms
 - Use a tissue or elbow to cough or sneeze into and use bins for tissue waste - “Catch it, bin it, kill it”
 - Inform a member of staff immediately if they see anything that concerns them or if they start to feel unwell.

The College will:

- Follow the Government’s Coronavirus guidance relating to the college’s responsibilities to students, staff and users.
- Maintain the cleanliness of the Sports Centre and implement controls to reduce the risk of transmission of the virus. Therefore changing rooms, lockers and showers will **NOT** be permitted.
- Provide hand sanitising stations within the Sports Centre and around the 3G.
- Schedule the arrival and departure of users by staggering usage of internal and external facilities.
- A one way system is in place within the Sports Centre.
- Provide 2 accessible toilets for use within the Sports Centre.
- Waste facilities available outside the 3G will be monitored and more frequent rubbish collection will be in operation.
- The side gates to each 1/3rd of the pitch will be open so users can access their individual pitch, avoiding all traffic using the main entrance and exit on pitch 1.
- Internal and external signage will clearly direct people to where you can wash hands (accessible toilets).
- Regularly review how people walk through the Sports Centre and adjustments made if necessary.
- Provide extra supervision in the early stages to help users to adapt to the new protocols. Positive encouragement and reinforcement will be used, repeat offenders and those who totally disregard Government guidance will be requested to leave the premises.
- Use PPE whenever there is an increased risk of transmission due to a specific activity being undertaken.
- Comply with the Government’s Test & Trace Programme as required.
