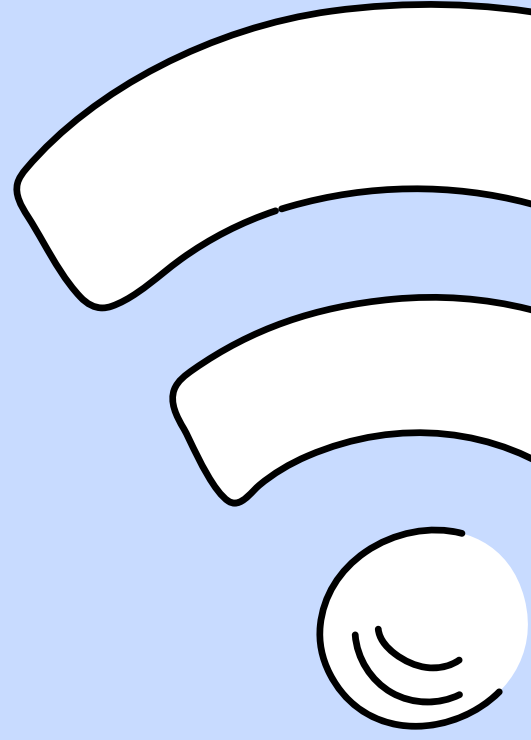




Online Safety – Code of Conduct



Guidance for All Members

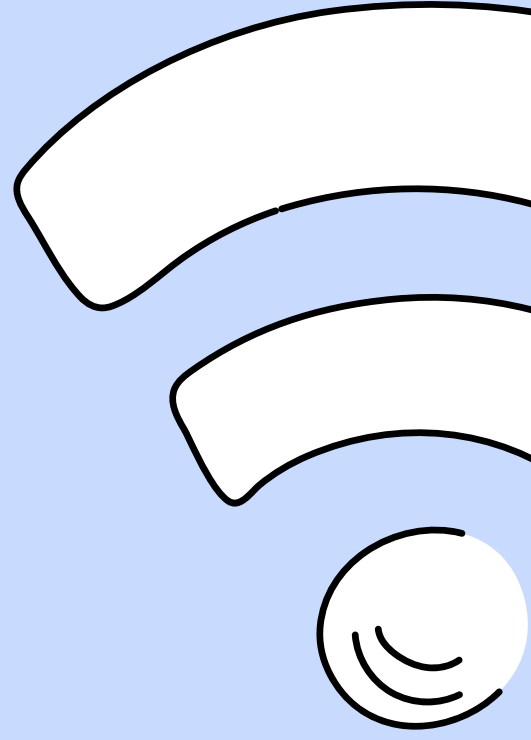
- ✓ **Be respectful and polite in all online communications.**
- ✓ **Only post or share content that shows volleyball and the club in a positive way.**
- ✓ **Protect your personal information and don't share personal details such as address, phone numbers etc.**
- ✓ **Report any messages or online behaviour that makes you feel uncomfortable.**
- ✗ **Don't post negative, hurtful or abusive comments about players, coaches, officials or the club.**
- ✗ **Don't use social media to bully, harass or embarrass others.**

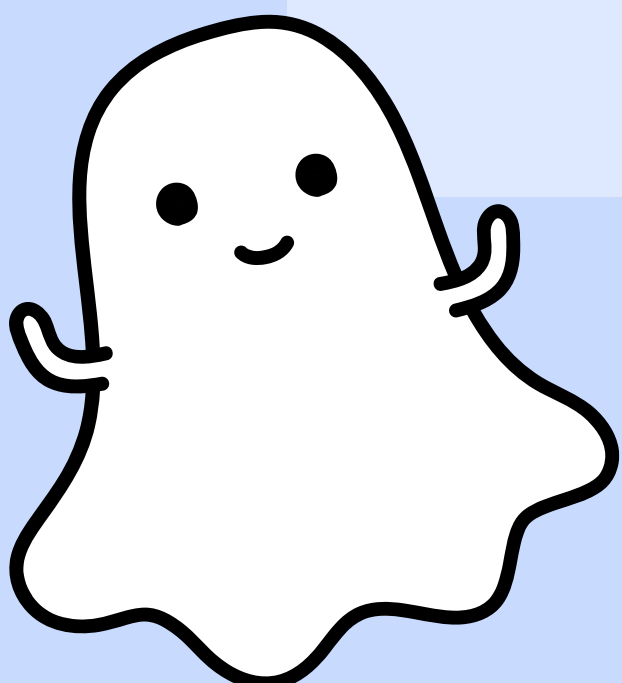
Online Safety – Code of Conduct



Guidance for Young Members

- ✓ **Set your privacy settings to “Friends Only” or “Private.”**
- ✓ **Only connect with people you know in real life.**
- ✓ **Tell your parent, carer or coach if you see something online that worries you.**
- ✗ **Don't share personal details such as information about your school**
- ✗ **Don't share or repost inappropriate images, videos or language.**
- ✗ **Don't accept friend requests from unknown users or adults.**

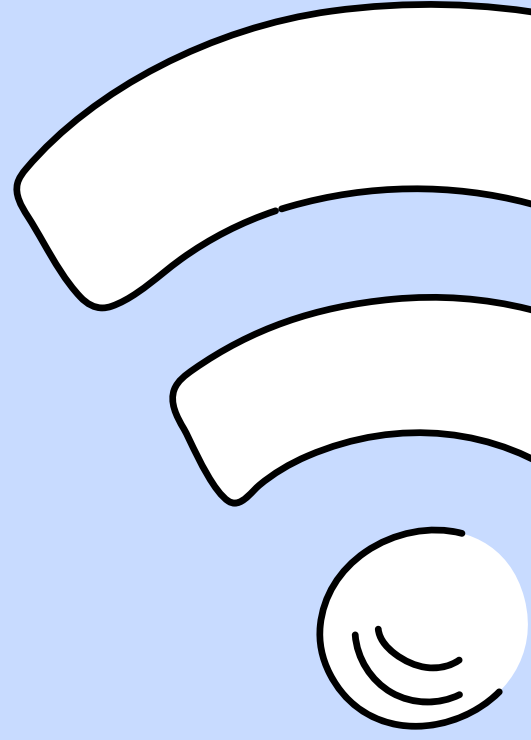

Guidance for Coaches, Volunteers & Adults in Positions of Trust



- ✓ **Communicate with young people only for volleyball related matters.**
- ✓ **Use group messages and include parents/carers whenever possible.**
- ✓ **Keep all interactions transparent and professional.**
- ✗ **Don't send private messages to young players.**
- ✗ **Don't accept or send friend/follow requests to young people on personal social media accounts.**
